

ER2115 Single Part Heat Cure Epoxy

DESCRIPTION

ER2115 is a heat cured fracture resistant epoxy used for adhesive and potting applications where high glass transition temperatures and increased chemical resistance are required. ER2115 is specially formulated to survive the rapid shear impacts caused by thermal and mechanical shock. It adheres to steel, brass, copper, stainless steel, tin plated surfaces, aluminum and most engineering plastics. Best results are achieved when the product is cured according to the cure schedule shown below.
